

TPCDT organises free health check-up camp at Tiruldih

In line with this endeavour Tiruldih team organized a free health check-up camp for the communities living in the Kukru block of Saraikela – Kharsawa district in Jharkhand.

The objective of organizing these health camps was to reach out to the most vulnerable groups that primarily include senior citizens and communities who cannot afford proper medical facilities. The Tiruldih team organised a total of 53 health camps in surrounding villages. The beneficiaries were treated for various diseases such as viral fever, anaemia, worm infestation, common cold, weakness, tonsillitis, body ache, URTI, rhinitis ring worm infestation and boils. The camps provided medical consultation and free medicines as prescribed. The camps also sensitized the community on various diseases and their preventive measures.

Speaking on the occasion, Mr. Asim Thakurta, Chief - Corporate Projects, Tata Power said, “Health of our stakeholders is of prime importance to us and we have always endeavoured to help improve the quality of life of the communities living around our areas of operation.
